WHAT IS A SAR and WHY DO I NEED IT?

When you submit your FAFSA, it produces a summary report called a SAR (Student Aid Report). The SAR contains all the information you supplied and may have comments or requests for information. It's important that your SAR is complete and accurate, so you should review all the information on your SAR and address any comments there may be.

The CITSTS Financial Aid Office [FAO] will receive the exact same information electronically in the form of an ISIR (Institutional Student Information Record). The ISIR is used by the Financial Aid Office to establish student eligibility for certain Title IV financial assistance programs, and the amounts you will be offered.
